Changes to Coronavirus Precautions

On Sunday 17th October our arrangements will change. Some restrictions will remain.

These revised arrangements will be kept under review.

- Ground floor – we retain 1-metre social distancing and the wearing of face coverings except the back three rows.
- Galleries – no social distancing and face coverings optional.
- Hymnbooks will be used in place of hymnsheets.
- The offering arrangements will remain the same – offering to be made on leaving.
- Hand sanitising on entry to the Tabernacle will continue to be offered.
- Pews will be sanitised after the Sunday morning service.
- Lunch facilities at the Tabernacle will be extended to families whose children attend the Sunday School, and those attending other afternoon meetings. Friends should bring a packed lunch with their own plates and utensils. The kitchen and washing up facilities will be closed.
- Current Morning School arrangements will continue.
- We must urge any who feel unwell with a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste, not to come to services until tested.

These new arrangements apply from Sunday 17th October for all Sunday and Wednesday services.

The Prayer Meeting on Mondays continues online for the time being.
